Are you ready for an adventure? Get ready to excavate truth at this summer's biggest event at First Baptist Church. We will uncover the TRUTH about God's creation and design of our amazing bodies.

Our VBS adventure is called **The Egypt File—Decoding the Mystery of Life**. Our theme verse is Psalm 139:14 which says *"I will praise You for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Marvelous are Your works, and that my soul knows very well."* As we dig into God's Word, we will uncover truth about **ape-men frauds**, the **amazing design of our bodies**, why we need to **protect and respect life**, and the fact that we were **created for a reason!**

In planning for this summer's VBS, we gave special attention to the busy schedules of families in today's culture. Swimming lessons, sport competitions, vacations, and church activities top the list on the summer calendars of many families. In responding to that fact, we are excited to announce our ONE-DAY VBS taking place in August. The day will be **FULL** of God's truth and super activities.

Schedule: Our doors will open Saturday morning, August 7, at 8:30, for your child to sign in (if preregistered) or to register as a walk-in. Your child will meet his/her team leader and be immediately channeled into an age-appropriate activity. At 8:50 the children will move into the sanctuary for the first of three group rallies. During these rallies, the children will sing, watch an exciting drama, learn cool facts about God's specific design of our bodies, and participate in activities and challenges.

Following the opening rally, the students will begin their rotation through 11 different stations--all specifically designed to reinforce the day's theme. There will be a conventional class time, two "Excavation Sites", lunch, and inflatable obstacle courses/games. The "Excavation Sites" are hands-on, out-of-a-chair activities (i.e., team puzzles or activities) that will teach an apologetic truth. It will be a full day, but one packed full with a variety of fun activities which will most likely have your child wanting to stay after 3:00 p.m.



Structure: We are planning for eight “Adventure Teams” (classes)--one for each school grade from Pre-K through 6th grade. Each adventure team will have two adult team leaders and a name that corresponds to an ancient Egyptian trade such as “silversmiths” or “astronomers”. The team leaders’ primary objectives will be to attend to their students’ well-being as they check in and rotate from station to station.

Closing: At 3:00 p.m., each class will be assigned to a designated room from which you, as the parent, or whoever you designate, may pick up your child. It is important for you to know as a parent that we will keep your child in our care and under our supervision until he/she is checked-out. To enable us in accomplishing this, please let us know who will be picking up your child. We understand that your plans may change beyond your control, but it is imperative that we be sure your child is in appropriate hands when leaving our facility. Feel free to make a list of suitable adults who may check out your son or daughter and if need be, please use the space provided in the registration form to let us know of anyone who should **NOT** pick up your child.

Closing Program: This is a one-day event; however, we encourage EVERYONE to join us the next day, August 8 at 6 p.m. for our closing program at which time we will be finishing the exciting drama begun the day before. Your child will also be able to participate with his/her class in singing and reciting a class verse. A picture presentation of the previous day’s events will also be shown.
